It is Carnival, the biggest party of the year on Curaçao. No less than 5 parades with thousands of people walking, dancing and jumping in the streets of Willemstad, while many more people are watching the parades as they are passing by.

The costumes, the make-up, the music trucks, the tribunes, the public... everybody and everything is decorated with loads of shiny glitter! So far the fun news....

The sad news is that all those tonnes and tonnes of glitter go into the gutter, it ends up in our oceans, our fish eat it, we eat the fish and we drink the water. We MUST be responsible and make really urgent changes!



Plastic Free Curacao

Glitter is a micro-plastic, which causes harm to marine life that mistake it for food. As a result, humans can ingest the micro-plastics via seafood and even tap water. Balloons also cause major problems, with the attached strings strangling birds, while other animals and sea life often mistake the shape of a burst balloon for jellyfish.

Almost nowhere is life as quiet, peaceful and friendly as on Bonaire. So after all the partying take some time and enjoy this beautiful island.







